APPROVAL OF FINANCIAL REPORTS

BUSINESS DISCUSSED

- Engineering Report
 - Lead service line inventory was reported to MN Dept of Health by 8/15 with several "unknown" types. All service lines will need to be identified by type to rule out lead once State finalizes process of determination and what funding may be available.
 - Sept/Oct timeframe for concept work on Lagoon system, surveying must be done after harvest but before snow fall. Dave Bosma will send tile maps to ISG.
 - Additional televising is needed, council reviewed and approved Empire proposal on motion made by Lair, seconded by Opdahl. Motion carried.
- Playground Equipment Installation Council has reached out to Roger Olson to lead the installation as he has several yrs experience. ISG also has a Sports & Rec department if the city needs any additional assistance.
- Property at 147 Lake St E has an interested buyer, Clerk to call realtor and discuss condition of utilities.
- Sabin property update Court is scheduled for Nov 29th zoom meeting
- Large Shed on Emmons Ave council has requested city attorney send a 'Cease and Desist-Removal of noncompliant building' letter. No permits have been requested or granted.
- City will invest in a 10 Month CD with Security Bank with an interest rate of 4.60%. Motion made by Lair to transfer \$450,000 from Savings to open the CD, seconded by Sorbo, motion carried. The clerk will make the arrangements with the bank.
- Street repair on Concord & Main city will try to coordinate with Vet Memorial sidewalk for repair. Lair stated the city should consider making additional repairs in front of Post Office and Bank.
